1500 citizens to get digital literacy training

The Ministry of Digital Transformation (MDT) and The Youth Training and Employment Partnership Programme (YTEPP) are continuing their partnership to deliver digital literacy training to an additional 1,500 citizens of Trinidad and Tobago. This four-week training will be offered at no cost to the participants.

While training is being offered in an online format, persons are also invited to visit our ICT Access Centres for access to desktop devices, reliable internet connection and/or hands-on, personalised assistance in using digital technology.

This training opportunity will focus on digital and life skills training such as:

- Safe use of the internet and computer;
- Efficient use of the internet and email;
- Creation of Microsoft Word documents;
- Usage of Microsoft Office;
- Completion and submission of online forms and
- How to access and use online government services.

In 2022, MDT and YTEPP had a successful partnership which offered training to 1000 citizens. Successful graduates of the programme have reported that they were able to access government services online and benefited from improved levels of digital literacy.

During the registration process, interested persons will be asked questions to help us determine how to improve their learning experience. For example, a citizen completing the form may be asked how many hours they will be available to learn.
